- 25X1 1. On 1 June 1954, and again on 2 June, about six flights by IL-28's were observed at Werneuchen airfield.
- 2., On 31 May a troop train of 13 boxcars and 18 flatcars arrived at Werneuchen from Brest-Litovsk.
3. An AAA battery of six 37-mm. AA guns and a battery of six 76.2 mm. AA guns are emplaced at Werneuchen airfield.
- 25X1  Comment. Up to 31 May 1954, six troop trains had arrived at Werneuchen from Brest-Litovsk, with a total of 151 boxcars and 90 flatcars.
