REMARKS

1. At 10 a.m. on 4 May 1954, a train of 31 flatcars and 10 boxcars carrying 12 x 87-mm AA guns and 25 motor vehicles was seen at the loading ramp of the Stendal railroad station. About 40 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets were observed on the loading ramp. [Redacted]

2. At 0:40 a.m. on 5 May, a train of 22 boxcars and an undetermined number of flatcars carrying 2 amphibious vehicles, 2 radio trucks and several boxcarloads of billeting equipment was seen at the loading ramp of the Tangerhuetten railroad station. 2

3. At 9:30 a.m. on 8 May, a shipment of 8 x 85-mm AA guns, 40 trucks [Redacted] and about 450 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets passed through the Stendal railroad station, proceeding toward Wittenberge. 3

1. [Redacted] Comment. If the train was loaded in Stendal, the entrained units may have belonged to the known AAA unit of the air force from Stendal, which possibly transferred to Gostrow.

2. [Redacted] Comment. Probably one of the two shipments [Redacted] which [Redacted] went to Tangerhuetten with units of the unidentified engineer battalion of the 1st Mtz Rifle Corps. [Redacted] The battalion is fairly definitely believed to have transferred to the summer camp of the Bittkau engineer training site.
