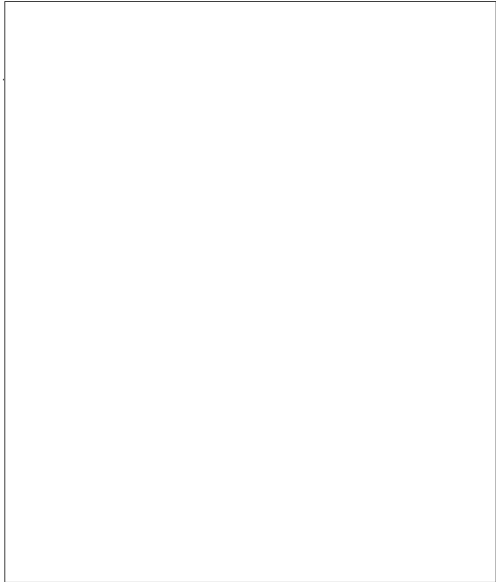

- 1.  Comment. Polish hard coal shipments consigned to industrial enterprises. The shipments to Ziltendorf are consigned to the Foundry Combine East at Fuerstenberg/Oder. 25X1
- 2.  Comment. Uranium ore shipments to the USSR. 25X1
- 3.  Comment. New railroad cars exported to the USSR.
- 4.  Comment. Fuel shipments to the USSR which are transloaded at Stettin.
- 5.  Comment. The number of empty grain  trains dispatched to the USSR increased. Therefore sizeable grain imports from the USSR may be expected after a considerable drop of such shipments in the preceding weeks. 25X1
- 6.  Comment. This shipment was consigned to the air force depot at Strausberg. 25X1
