1. A large and well equipped Soviet General Hospital is located at Dresden N 6, Marien Allee 13. The installation allegedly has a capacity of 500 beds, 60 percent of which are usually occupied. The hospital caters to a fairly large area, which includes Leipzig, Meissenfels, Magdeburg, Zwickau, Riesa and Meissen. Patients from all these cities have been seen. Patients are brought to the hospital by truck, ambulance and passenger cars, but some arrive by train, if they are able to walk. Patients are usually accompanied by medical officers or noncommissioned officers, who carry the papers pertaining to the case. When ready for discharge, units are notified to pick up patients, who are never permitted to rejoin their units by themselves.

2. [redacted] Officers attached to the hospital as staff reside in private requisitioned dwellings adjacent to the main hospital building (Marion Allee 10, 11, 12, Waldschloesschenstrasse 19.)

4. All of the residential addresses are in a blocked-off and guarded area. German employees at the hospital are in possession of red passes (propusk) with their pictures on them, which enable them to pass the gate guards. Most German nationals have been discharged, and only approximately twelve remain, all of whom perform menial jobs.
