REMARKS

This is UNEVALUATED

1. At about 2200 on 25 May 1954, the long front of the barracks installation on Al. Wojska Polskiego in Stettin was almost completely dark. The only lights seen were in rooms beside the entrances. No soldiers or motor traffic were observed. Only the gates of the installation were guarded. At about 0530 on 26 May 1954, all windows of the barracks were shut. The only soldiers seen were the sentries at the gates who wore red service color.
2. No military motor traffic was observed on Al. Wojska Polskiego and in the city area on 25 and 26 May 1954. The Polish troops stationed at the installation on Al. Wojska Polskiego had probably left the station.

Comment. It is believed that the units stationed in Stettin went to summer camp probably in early May. During the reported period, the 12th Inf Div whose bulk is stationed at Stettin probably practiced in the Drankburg area where it had been in 1953.
