This is UNEVALUATED

1. On about 15 May 1954, there was air activity by biplanes with Polish national markings at the Biala Podlaska (S 5334 UIC 4667) airfield. Nineteen biplanes were parked at the field, with 3 others here also. The aircraft made local flights. There was a small amount of air activity apparently conducted by student pilots; one aircraft made a low landing.
2. During repeated observations of the field, the last being around 15 May, it was determined that a section of the landing field was used for air activity.
3. Construction work had decreased. No work was going on at the foundation which was apparently for a new hangar. The newly constructed quartering buildings in the northwestern corner of the field appeared to be occupied. An estimate of 125 to 150 soldiers were seen at the buildings while about 50 other soldiers were seen near the parked aircraft.

           Biala Podlaska airfield continued to be occupied by a Polish flying school.
