Independent School for Trudovak Officers

1. [redacted] until 1 January 1953 Trudovak officers were trained with the line units at the "Vasil Levski" military school. [redacted] Newly graduated officers are first assigned to a Trudovak unit, wearing the uniform of line officers and receive those of Trudovak officers from the unit to which they are sent.
2. After 1 January 1953, however, the training of Trudovak officers was taken away from the "Vasil Levski" military school and assigned to a separate independent school for Trudovak officers [redacted]
