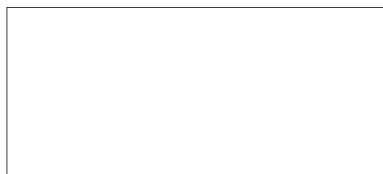

On 1 June 1954, Schulz (fnu), managing engineer and Korthals (fnu) the new general manager of Yachtwerft Berlin-Koepenick (yacht-building yard) visited the Peenewerft (shipyard) in Wolgast to discuss the Stoer-program (sic) with designer Schlaak. A total of 12 Stoer-type vessels was scheduled to be built in 1955. The twelve boats will have wooden hulls and be equipped with two 12M-engines of 1,400 hp each similar to the Habicht-type vessels.
