1. At about 0830 on 26 June 1954, 8 JS-3 tanks [redacted] 25X1
 and jeep [redacted] went from the Panzer Kaserne [redacted] 25X1
 in Neubrandenburg to the railroad station. The vehicles were
 probably entrained at the railroad station.¹

2. At about 1000 on 2 July, 1 large motorboat, 1 small motorboat and
 15 trucks carrying pontoons were entrained at the Neubrandenburg
 railroad station. [redacted] 25X1

Truck [redacted] was seen on the loading ramp. At about 1045
 on the same day, about 15 engineer soldiers loaded beams, logs and
 boards on a flatcar at the loading point just north of the waterworks
 about 500 meters north-northwest of Panzer Kaserne. Three empty boxcars
 were attached to the flatcar. Three trucks and 1 crane truck were seen
 at the loading point. An amphibious vehicle shuttled several times between
 the loading ramp of the railroad station and the loading point north of
 the waterworks. The entrained unit had come from the north section of
 Panzer Kaserne.² 25X1

3. In the morning on 26 June, local residents observed about 10 tanks which
 went from Panzer Kaserne to the Neubrandenburg loading station, presumably
 for entraining.¹ 25X1

4. At about 1800 on 3 July, about 10 trucks with pontoons, about 18 trucks
 with trailers, 1 field kitchen, 2 amphibious vehicles, 2 motorboats and
 7 boxcarloads of troops were entrained at the Neubrandenburg railroad
 station. [redacted] 25X1
 The train went south at about 1830.²

5. Loadings and unloadings observed at the Dallgow-Doberitz railroad station
 between 29 June and 4 July included: 25X1

22 June. At about 1400, unloading of 20 prime movers, 12 x 105-mm M1 guns,
 20 trucks, 1 field kitchen, 1 jeep and 12 boxcarloads of troops wearing rei-
 lounded black epaulets. The unit left for the tank sheds west of
 C. [redacted] 25X1

2 July. In the evening, loading of about 40 trucks, 12 x 76.2-mm field
 guns, 1 ration supply truck, 2 repair shop trucks, 2 jeeps, 1 ambulance,

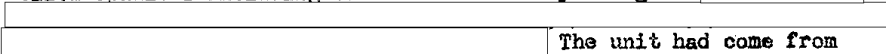

2 field kitchens and 14 boxcarloads of troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets including some with artillery insignia.

The unit had come from Olympisches Dorf. The train went west at 2200.

4 July. Loading of 12 x 100-mm AT guns, 12 prime movers, about 30 trucks, 1 repair shop truck, 1 ambulance, 1 jeep, and 12 boxcarloads of troops. The unit presumably came from the tank sheds west of Olympisches Dorf. The train went west at 1500.

- 1.  Comment. This shipment of a tank detail of the unidentified Gds Iiv Tank SP Regt of the 9th Gds Tank Div from Panzer Kaserne  Neubrandenburg, which presumably departed for firing practices, is believed to be identical with a train which on 26 June, was observed at the Neustrelitz railroad station with the engine headed toward Berlin.
