- Bridge F 87-B-1 over the Oder - Spree Canal near Muellrose, on 22 June 1954;
- Bridge F 169-Sa- over the railroad line at Lauchhammer, on 23 June 1954;
- Bridge AEB-S-213 at Frankenberg, on 23 June 1954;
- Bridge ABD-B-12 over the railroad line at Ruhland, on 28 June 1954;
- Bridge F 184-SA-8 over Lake Fährsee near Dessau, on 1 July 1954.

[Redacted] Comment. The bridges mentioned were included in the 1954 bridge construction program which listed a total of 60 construction projects.
