1. [redacted] Comment. Compared to the last reported period, grain imports from the USSR increased from a daily average of 86 carloads to 137 carloads. In connection with the reorganization of Soviet transit traffic through Poland, most of the grain imports previously directed through Frankfurt/Oder arrived via Guben after 1 July 1954. [redacted] Coal imports from Poland decreased from a daily average of 165 carloads to 147 carloads.
2. [redacted] Comment. The number of empty boxcars to be used for grain shipments increased from a daily average of 28 to 82 cars. The number of empty gondola cars for coal shipments decreased from 317 to 239 cars per day.
3. [redacted] Comment. Effective 1 [redacted] in each direction are scheduled to pass through [redacted] including 9 trains for Soviet transit traffic, 7 trains for hard coal imports, and 3 trains for German-Polish freight and passenger traffic. [redacted] paragraph 3.
