Comment. Compared to May 1954, uranium ore shipments decreased by 305 tons.

Train sections dispatched from the railroad stations mentioned are usually assembled into trains of 45 boxcars and sent to Brest Litovsk via Frankfurt/Oder. One or two cars for Soviet escort personnel are also attached to the ore trains.
