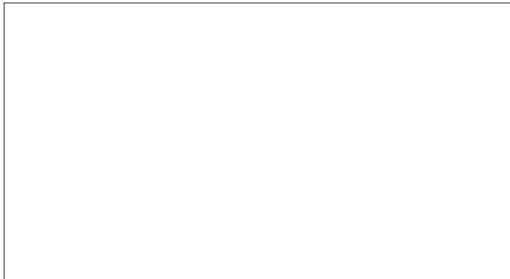

1. The fall maneuvers of the Seepolizei started on 20 September. All coastal patrol boats and all vessels of the Schwalbe, Delphin, Tuemmler, and Habricht type were involved in these exercises. The allegedly intended participation of Soviet naval vessels was cancelled because of the nearness of the East German general elections in October. 25X1
2. The problem for the maneuvers is the defense against enemy forces attacking Ruegen Island. Seven vessels of the Sea Hydrographic Service assumed the following positions on 21 September: The LOUIS KRUEGER near Stralsund-Daenholm, the SENTA at the north mole of Stralsund harbor, the MAGNETOLOGE in Stralsund harbor, the HYDROGRAPH off Kroeslin, the GAUSS outside Sassnitz harbor, the ARKONA at the north mole of Sassnitz harbor, and motor launch [redacted] which is to be used as a courier vessel, in Stralsund harbor. 25X1
