1. Comment. Compared to the last reported period, grain imports decreased from a daily average of 96 carloads to 80 carloads. Hard coal imports from Poland increased from a daily average of 116 carloads to 125 carloads.

2. Comment. Compared to the last reported period, the number of empty boxcars for grain shipments decreased from 66 to 14 units per day. The partition walls will be used for boxcars in which grain is shipped. The number of empty gondola cars for coal shipments from Poland increased from 202 to 264 units per day. The tank car shipments were dispatched by East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR.
