Border-police vessels [Redacted] and some small motor boats, sea-police vessels [Redacted] (a launch), [Redacted] (ex-Lumme), [Redacted] (cutter), [Redacted] (tugboats), and [Redacted] (a small tugboat). On 20 June 1954 boats [Redacted] were also in the harbor.

2. On 29 June 1954, boats [Redacted] put into Sassnitz. It was learned from a sea police member that these boats were to be permanently stationed in Sassnitz from that time on.

[Redacted] Comment. Habicht-type vessel [Redacted] were the first group of the MIA Division (minesweeper-layers) [Redacted] service. Prior to 30 June 1954, the group was stationed at the Peenemuende fleet base. [Redacted] which was not among the vessels which put into Sassnitz, was at the Peenewerft in June 1954 to get her degaussing equipment installed.
