- On 27 October thirteen MIG's flew over the T'oumen (N 28-42, E 121-46) area. Two of them flew south to Sungmen (N 28-20, E 121-36) and returned north via Tach'en.

- On 28 October twelve MIG's and eight LA-11's flew over the T'oumen-Haimen (N 28-40, E 121-36) area. Junk traffic in the Haimen-T'oumen area was light but an LST was sighted proceeding north west of Chikushan (N 28-24, E 121-44).

Comment. Except for renewed shelling on Ichiang (N 28-36, E 121-48), activity in the Tach'en area was below normal during these two days. The low level of junk traffic was probably due to rough seas.
