- Between 0500Z and 0900Z on 25 October there were six MIG's and four LA-11's in the T'oumen (N 28-42, E 121-46) -Haimen (N 28-40, E 121-26) area. Two of the LA-11's flew over Sungmen (N 28-20, E 121-36) and returned north.

- On 25 October an LCM and a junk were in the area north of Chikushan (N 28-24, E 121-44) and vessels patrolled the T'oumen-Kinmentao (N 28-48, E 121-52) area.<sup>1</sup>
- On 26 October four MIG's and two LA-11's flew over the T'oumen-Haimen area.
