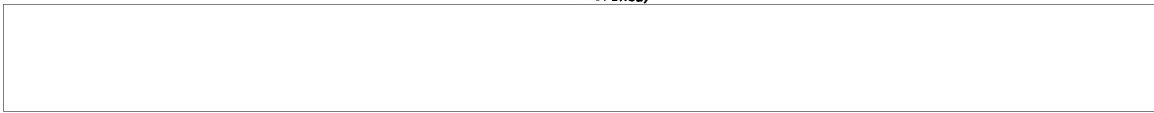

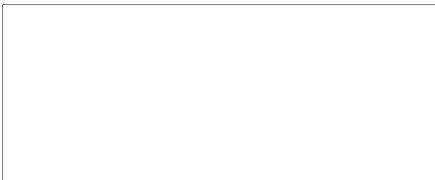

1. [REDACTED] ship was in the port of Arkhangelsk [REDACTED] three small naval vessels at the Dvina Lightship. In Arkhangelsk harbor, there were 20 minesweepers [REDACTED]
2. There were eight aircraft at the airfield on Keg Island. These aircraft appeared to be passenger planes. In the south section of the field [REDACTED] a number of well-camouflaged tanks; at a distance they resembled a white fence. 25X1
3. There were two small floating drydocks in Arkhangelsk harbor. A merchant ship of about 2,500 tons was in one drydock, and in the other there was a small naval vessel. 25X1
4. [REDACTED] went to the Seamen's Hospital to visit a fellow countryman who had undergone surgical treatment. The patient had a private room, as did other non-Soviet patients. The Soviets were provided space in larger wards. [REDACTED] was satisfied with the treatment he had received from the doctors and nurses. The food was not particularly tasty, and it was strongly spiced and usually badly prepared. Butter was rationed but it could be obtained at a high price. The hygienic conditions and requirements were not particularly high. 25X1
