REMARKS This is UNEVALUATED Information

1. Between 28 September and 2 October 1954, no air activity was observed at Finow airfield from the direction of Eberswalde. At 1400 on 2 October, 55 to 60 MIG-15s or U-MIG-15s were parked at the northern edge of the field. 25X1

2. The AA gun emplacement in the southeastern corner of the field was still occupied by 6 x 37-mm AA guns.

1. [redacted] Comment. It is believed that Finow airfield is still occupied by a fighter division headquarters and two fighter regiments. [redacted]

2. [redacted] Comment. The AA gun emplacement in the southeastern corner of the landing field has repeatedly been reported. 25X1
