between 25 and 30 September 1954:

1. On 30 September, 40 flatcars with undetermined load from Brandenburg to Brest-Litovsk [redacted]
2. On 26 September, 2 trains, one with 75 the other with 45 new trucks from Brest-Litovsk to Frankfurt/Oder.<sup>1</sup> 50X1-HUM
- On 27 September, 45 boxcars with ammunition from Brest-Litovsk to Frankfurt/Oder.<sup>2</sup>
3. On 25 September, 32 flatcars with undetermined load from Magdeburg to Brest-Litovsk [redacted]
- On 29 September, 36 flatcars with undetermined from Justerbog-Altes Lag Brest-Litovsk [redacted] 50X1-HUM
4. On 27 September, 1 train with 75 new trucks from Brest-Litovsk; 58 of the trucks to Rathenow, 17 to Spereberg.<sup>1</sup> 50X1-HUM
5. On 27 September, 46 boxcars with ammunition from Torgau to Brest-Litovsk.<sup>3</sup> 50X1-HUM

1. [redacted] Comment. These shipments were connected with the motor vehicle exchange program.

2. [redacted] Comment. This ammunition shipment from the USSR to Frankfurt/Oder was probably forwarded from there to a large ammunition depot. 50X1-HUM

3. [redacted] Comment. A large Soviet ammunition depot is located at Torgau. The reported shipment probably consisted of empty shells which were returned to the USSR. 50X1-HUM
