1. The Central Agricultural Institute (Centralny Instytut Rolniczy) is located in Warsaw on Ulica Gurskiego 7. This Institute is part of the Ministry of Agriculture (Ministerstwo Rolnictwa) and was created in 1952. The mission of the Institute is to provide agricultural literature to the Polish peasants and farmers. The Institute translates agricultural books from Russian into Polish and sees that these books are distributed among Polish farmers. It also publishes weekly and monthly agricultural journals and manages two experimental stations, where new agricultural techniques are tested and developed. One of these experimental stations is in the Warsaw area.
2. The director of the Central Agricultural Institute is Stanislaw Podgurski.
3. The Central Agricultural Institute planned to send the following employees to the Moscow Fair of 1954:
  - a. Director Stanislaw Podgurski
  - b. Publications Chief Zarzyck (fmu)
  - c. Drewnak (fmu), function unknown
