a concrete runway was to be constructed at Bautzen-Litten airfield. It was learned on 6 October that the contract for this work was cancelled. It could not be determined whether the construction project was suspended or given up completely. 25X1

[redacted] 2. During an official conference on 10 October it was learned that the planned construction of a concrete runway at Bautzen-Litten airfield 25X1

could not be carried out for financial reasons. It was unknown whether the scheduled project was abandoned or suspended.

[redacted] Comment. In early September 1954, the Soviets ordered that all auxiliary runways of mats be replaced by concrete runways. This order also includes Bautzen-Litten airfield which has an auxiliary runway about 2,200 meters long and is covered with mats. It appears possible that the reported cancellation of the construction order is only temporary. 25X1
