1. Between 1140 and 1630 on 21 October 1954, no air activity was observed at Zerbst airfield. Aircraft parked at the field included 3 MiG-15s or U-MiG-15s at the eastern end of the runway, 3 MiG-15s or U-MiG-15s and 4 single-engine aircraft in front of the flight control station. One of the latter aircraft was painted light blue. The western hangar was open and the outlines of 4 aircraft were indistinctly seen. 1 25X1
2. A Kniferest-type radar set was observed 30 meters away from the previously reported Dumbo-type radar set about 1 km southeast of the end of the runway. The two radar sets were located in a fenced-in wooded section which 2 soldiers patrolled. A van-like truck was parked next to the sets. No temporary buildings were observed. 2

Comment. It is believed that Zerbst airfield is still occupied by 1 fighter regiment and 1 reconnaissance regiment equipped with Il-10s. 25X1

Comment. The radar station 1 km southwest of the runway end in the extension of the runway is equipped with 1 Dumbo-type set and 1 Kniferest-type set. 25X1
