- 1. At 0630 on 3 November 1954, 20 x 152-mm field howitzers on 10 25X

 The barrels of the howitzers which were covered projected about 2
 meters beyond the protective shield, apparently had muzzle brakes and

 was on the right side behind the protective shield which was backward

Comment. The return from the summer camp of the 468th Gds

The observation of artillery pieces 25X1 in the Reiter Kaserne, which is believed to be occupied only by the mortar regirent, supports a previous assumption, according to which the medium mortar units of the mortar regiments were possibly reequipped with artillery pieces.
