The Executive Bureau of the International Union of Building Trades held a meeting early in September in Budapest, at which they decided to hold a conference of building, construction materials and wood industry workers on 17-23 March 1955 in East Berlin. The communists expect at least 300 representatives from various countries at this meeting. The main subject of the conference will be the international and national unity of workers, and its promotion. The conference plans to select a directorate of the international union, and will take up the financial report for the previous year. The conference reportedly will be open to all workers, regardless of their affiliations.
