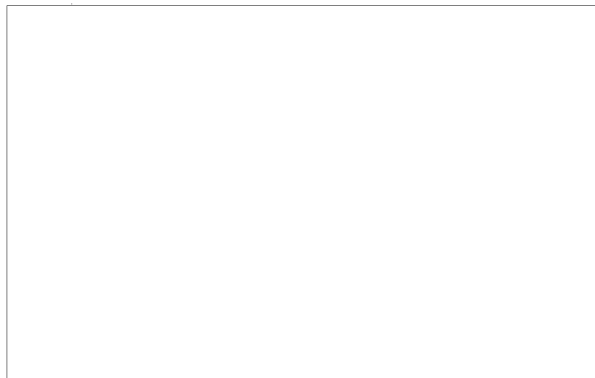

Comment. Compared to the last reported period, hard coal shipments from Poland increased from a daily average of 341 carloads to 389 carloads; the number of empty cars for coal shipments decreased from a daily average of 343 to 319. During the reported period, a daily average of 11 carloads of grain arrived from the USSR.
