REMARKS This is UNEVALUATED Information 25X1

1. At about 1300 on 16 November 1954, one of the five helicopters stationed at Neubrandenburg airfield made a local flight at an altitude of about 200 meters. 25X1
2. Between 15 November and 1 December, the occupation at the field was apparently unchanged. Twin-engine monoplanes were seen aloft but mostly in individual flights. Only once were 9 of these aircraft seen aloft at the same time. The individual aircraft repeatedly practiced blind-flying. The helicopters made short local flights on 15 and 16 November and 1 December only. 25X1
3. Trucks [redacted] were seen at the field.

[redacted] Comment. Neubrandenburg airfield is occupied by a transport regiment equipped with about 22 Li-2s and 5 type-36 helicopters. [redacted] 25X1
