3. Dr. Werner Lange, head of the Central Office for Research and Technology (ZAFT), may then assume the duties that are now being performed by Kerber. Lange would then be responsible for the functions of the Office for Standardization, ZAFT, and the Office for Goods Testing (DAMW).
