1. The main theme of recent organized political discussions of the Plant Police (Betriebschutzleute) was the action to be taken by East Germany if the Paris agreements should be ratified. 25X1
2. The following measures were said to have been decided upon:
 - a. Travel between East and West Berlin will be permitted only on the basis of Pasierscheine, which are allegedly already on the printing presses.
 - b. All persons resident in East Berlin who work in West Berlin at trades that are considered essential to the East German economy (Mangelberufe) will no longer be permitted to exchange DMWs at favorable rates.
 - c. Inter-sector S-Bahn and U-Bahn traffic will be restricted to persons with Pasierscheine, and the necessary control system will be instituted.
 - d. Unspecified restrictions will be levied on inter-zonal travel.
 - e. The "Nationalarmee" will be officially uncovered and therewith strict controls will be imposed on the travel of youth to West Berlin.
 - f. No Train tickets will be sold for trips from the provinces to Berlin unless the buyer can prove that his visit to Berlin is necessary.
 - g. Economic sanctions of an unknown nature, presumably against West Berlin, will be imposed.
