VEB Volkswerft Stralsund

1. VEB Volkswerft Stralsund employs some 6,000 men and operates two and three shifts.
2. The yard completes six luggers a month. On completion, these luggers are turned over to the Russians in Stralsund; they are taken to Koenigsberg and finally to the Caspian Sea.
3. The specifications of these luggers are as follows:

Length 36 meters
Beam 4.8 meters
Draught 2.10 meters
Drive 250 HP Buckau-Wolf diesel

4. Also located in Stralsund is the Betrieb Schiffsbergung which fits out cutters from Boizenburg, Brandenburg, and Rosslau. This establishment also builds vehicles for the Sea Police.
