1. [Redacted] ship visited Ventspils in April 1954, [Redacted] the ship was brought in without the help of a tug.
2. [Redacted] three tugboats of about 600 HP in the harbor. [Redacted] There were six or seven six-ton cranes on the export pier. Behind them were two smaller cranes used to lift coal to a discharging berth from which the large cranes loaded it.
