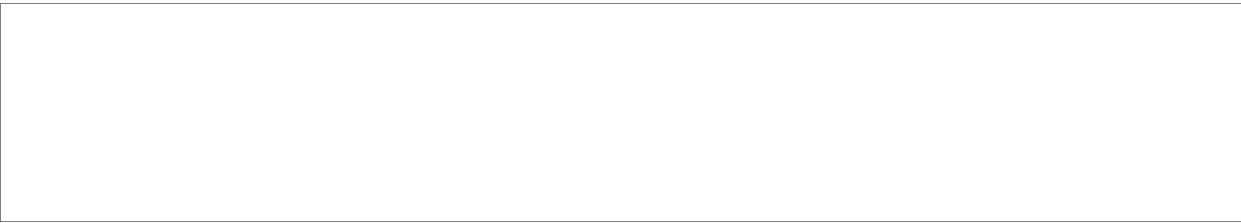

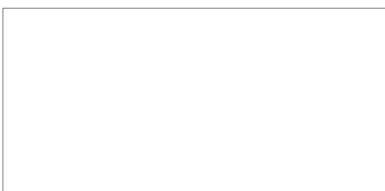

It was assumed that production output will be raised in the near future. At this conference, it was believed that the increased output can only be achieved by an excessive strain on the machinery. There was no material available for most of the required repairs. Further difficulties were caused by flood damage in 1954.
