3. On 13 December, a ship with butter allegedly arrived at Warnemuende. It was said that the butter was taken over by two trains of 15 refrigerator cars [redacted] and probably went to Leipzig.
4. In early December, a shipment of one car with large boxes from the plant for large engines "7 October" in Berlin-Weissensee was dispatched to Rostock-harbor almost daily.
5. In early December, nine shipments totalling 27 boxes were scheduled to be dispatched by the Trato-Werk in Berlin-Rummelsburg to Rostock-harbor for loading on a ship.

1. [Redacted] Comment. The volume of supply traffic in the Schwerin railroad district in December 1954 is the same as that of November 1954. [Redacted] 25X1
2. [Redacted] Comment. Some of the shipments were previously reported. [Redacted] 25X1
[Redacted] The Warnow-Werft (shipbuilding yard) in Warnemuende and Neptun-Werft in Rostock are listed as manufacturers of pontoons and pontoon parts. The material will possibly be used for the present construction of the large power plants on the Volga River. 25X1
3. [Redacted] Comment. The shipments belong to the supply traffic of the 119th Gds Tk SP Regt of the 18th Mecz Div. 25X1
4. [Redacted] Comment. The shipments belong to the supply traffic of the Northern Ftr Corps. It is noteworthy that the corps also participated in the motor vehicle exchange movement. 25X1
5. [Redacted] 25X1
6. [Redacted] Comment. The shipments belong to the motor vehicle exchange movement and contained trucks which were returned to the USSR. 25X1
7. [Redacted] Comment. No confirmation on military supply traffic by sea has been obtained so far. 25X1
