- Between 0800 and 1430 on 11 January 1955, 41 MiG-15s, 3 Yak-11s and 1 biplane were parked at Wiener Neustadt airfield. The "depression" could not be reconnoitered. No air activity or other activity was observed at the field. There was a 10/10 overcast at an altitude of about 1,000 meters, northwesterly wind of about 10 km/h, visibility of about 500 meters until about 1030 and after 1230 rain. The flight control station was guarded by a unit who wore black-bordered blue epaulets. Two sedans, 1 truck and 1 fire truck were parked in front of the installation. Several officers in fur coats, including 2 lieutenant colonels and 4 majors wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets entered and left the installation. Trucks [REDACTED] 25X1
[REDACTED] all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen in the traffic. Six trucks, 1 van-like truck and 4 Stalin tractors were parked under the lean-to roofs of the garage. Two van-like trucks, 1 tank truck and 1 trailer of a mobile flight control station were parked in the open. The doors of the garage were closed. Driving school truck [REDACTED] 25X1
truck [REDACTED] and van-like truck [REDACTED], all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, entered the installation. The southern AA gun emplacement was unoccupied and unguarded. Two van-like crates, 2 gray crates and 1 crane with block and tackle were seen at the aircraft repair shop northeast of the flight control station. 25X1
- The gates of the aircraft repair shop Theresienfeld were closed. One Li-2, 1 biplane, 23 gray crates, and 1 motor vehicle with hoisting device were seen in front of the hangar. Four trucks, [REDACTED] both of 25X1
them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, and 3 van-like trucks were seen in the parking lot of the installation. 25X1
- The following observations were made in Wiener Neustadt:
Two trucks and 1 van-like truck were parked in the yard of Artillerie Kaserne. 25X1
Van-like truck [REDACTED] and sedans [REDACTED] all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, the latter additionally occupied by an officer wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets entered the barracks installation. One truck, 2 van-like trucks and 2 jeeps were parked under the lean-to roof in the yard of Nachrichten Kaserne. There was traffic by personnel wearing black-bordered blue epaulets between the barracks installation and the airfield. No vehicular traffic was observed there. Sixteen 37-mm AA guns, 23 trucks and 4 trucks loaded with canvas-covered devices looking like AA machine guns were seen in the open at the cantonment west of Wiener Neustadt. jeep [REDACTED] all of them with drivers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, 25X1
