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6. The large assets transferred consist of a large warehouse and a number of smaller ones. The large warehouse was in the same condition as when the Germans had it. The Russians made no improvements; there are still some buildings destroyed in the war. The Russians also turned over to the Poles a large hall containing lathes. As a result of the transfer, the Poles obtained huge storage facilities and stores. Without these the Poles were pinched for space. After the transfer this problem no longer causes concern to the Polish port administration.

7. The Russian withdrawal from the port was completed during October 1954 but this fact is still kept secret. The Poles have since been administering this area. In addition, the transfer of the Russian sector at Nabrzeze Chorzowskie has been completed. This sector contained a number of workshops and two or three grames.

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
