3. On 8 January, a train of 52 flatcars with 58 new three-axle trucks was observed en route from Frankfurt/Oder to Potsdam-Wildpark.⁴ 25X1

4. [redacted] a train of 1 converted boxcar, 26 boxcars and 14 crash cars was dispatched from Taenchin to Brest-Litovsk on 19 January. [redacted] 25X1

5. The following shipments from Brest Litovsk [redacted]
 On 18 January, 25 flatcars to Riesa [redacted] and 23 flatcars and 1 converted boxcar to Bernburg [redacted]
 On 19 January, 51 flatcars and 1 converted boxcar to Kopen [redacted] UNCODED 25X1

6. [redacted], a train of 52 flatcars with new trucks and 1 converted boxcar with escort personnel was dispatched from Frankfurt/Oder-border to Stendal on 16 January. The trucks had dual tires in the rear, most of them were of ZIS 151 type.⁴

~~4-9~~ 7. [redacted] the following uranium ore shipments were dispatched from Aue to Brest-Litovsk via Frankfurt/Oder: One train consisting of 46 cars each on 4, 9 and 11 January [redacted]

2. [redacted] Comment. Raw material deliveries to the Eisenhuettenkombinat Ost (Foundry Combine East) at Fuerstenberg/Oder.

3. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries by East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR and empty cars returned from there.

4. [redacted] Comment. Truck shipments from the USSR in connection with the motor vehicle exchange program.

5. [redacted] Comment. This shipment was observed [redacted] at the Eberswalde railroad station on the same day.

6. [redacted] Comment. Intra-zonal shipment.

7. [redacted] Comment. This shipment was probably consigned to the equipment depot of the Twenty-Fourth Air Army in Strausberg.

8. [redacted] Comment. This shipment probably involved deactivated tanks of units of the Third Shock Army.

9. [redacted] Comment. Ammunition shipments from the USSR to the Soviet depots at Altengrabow and Kapen. The composition of the train to Kapen listed in paragraph 5 was probably incorrectly identified and consisted of 35 to 38 boxcars with ammunition and 13 or 14 empty flatcars as crash cars. The shipment from Toepchin probably consisted of ammunition or empty shells which were returned to the USSR. Since early 1955 [redacted]
