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1. On 1 January 1955 at 1000 hours, a train with fifty flatcars departed from Frankfurt/Oder for Brest. Each flatcar carried one truck. This train originated at Neuruppin. The train had one additional car which housed the railroad personnel and a guard detachment.
2. On 5 January 1955 at 1420 hours, a train with 46 cars of uranium departed from Frankfurt/Oder for Brest. This train carried a load of 1140 tons gross and 680 tons net. This train originated at the following points:
