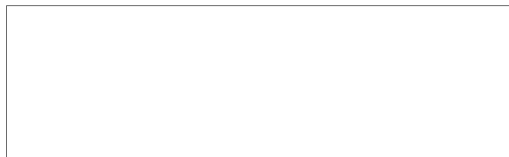

1. During January 1955, construction work at Wolfsbehringen airfield, because of the weather was not resumed. Of the local workers, an emergency detail had been organized at the construction site, while the non-local workers were given home leave with 60 percent pay until work could be resumed. It was not expected that work would begin until 14 days after the end of the frost period. 25X1
  
2. An initial investigation had been started against the construction supervisor and the business manager who had recognized overtime work without being fully authorized. Overtime work was permitted only in emergency cases and with special permission. Some of the overtime hours worked during the unloading operations of incoming construction material had not been approved so far by the Bauunion Sued. It appeared possible that the law proceedings would be started against the two men responsible.
