1. On 14 January 1955, no change was observed on the radar station south of the St Poelten-Witzendorf road. The station still consisted of 1 Dumbo-type set and 1 Kniferest-type set which were guarded by sentries wearing red-bordered black epaulets. No motor vehicles were seen parked there.

2. Between 1045 and 1200 on 30 January, the following motor vehicles and artillery pieces were parked in the area of the Flak Kaserne in Kagran:

- 24 trucks
- 3 Bedford-type van-like trucks
- 6 medium AA guns
- 6 x 37-mm AA guns
- 6 guns similar to light AA guns [redacted]

Eleven tank trucks were parked in the area of the fuel dump. Three 37-mm AA guns were emplaced in the southern section of the fuel dump.

[redacted] Comment. For sketch of gun similar to light AA gun, see Annex. These artillery pieces are light AA guns, presumably 14.5-mm SPU-type guns which at present are assigned to the Soviet Army. 25X1

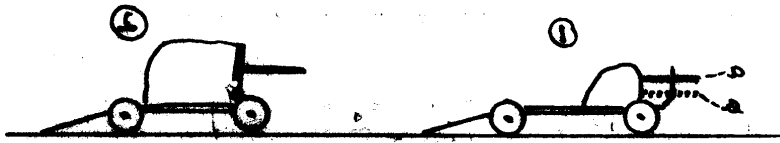

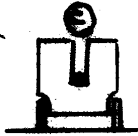
