Prior to August 1954, the following observations were made daily in Warsaw (52 15N/21 00 E).

A six-story building with entrance facing on Ul. Filtrawa was located at the corner [redacted] (northern side) and Ul. Raszynska (eastern side). [redacted] was located on the ground floor. [redacted] supplied [redacted] Polish military trucks but civilians could also [redacted]. It was not known if there were different sections and different prices for military and civilian personnel. The other floors of the building were occupied by Soviet officers and their dependents. The officers who were assigned to the Polish Air Force wore the blue gray Polish Air Force uniforms (sic) [redacted] were parked in front of the building. The dependents were definitely identified as Russians. A Soviet military bus transported the children to school. [redacted] singing of Russian songs was repeatedly heard from the house. [redacted] intervals, officers wearing Soviet uniforms, were also seen entering the building.

Comment. These observations once again confirm the fact that Soviet officers are assigned to the Polish Air Force.
