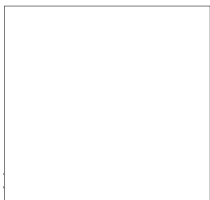

1. [redacted] Comment. The data indicate that these shipments consisted of tanks of the new T-54 type. The shipments on 9 March, recorded in paragraphs 1 and 4 of the present report are probably identical. [redacted]

2. [redacted] Comment. These shipments possibly consisted also of new tanks. On 25 February 1955, a similar unidentified shipment had been reported. [redacted]

4. [redacted] Comment. Intra-zonal shipment. [redacted]

5. [redacted] Comment. Raw material deliveries to the Eisenhuettenkombinat Ost (Foundry Combine East) at Puerstenberg/Oder which is served by the Ziltendorf railroad station.

6. [redacted] Comment. These cars probably belong to the 1,040 empty tank cars for white products which were ordered by the Soviets to be dispatched to Brest Litovsk. [redacted]

7. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries by East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR and empty cars returned from the USSR.

8. [redacted] Comment. Aircraft with accessories, possibly jet aircraft, consigned to the VPL. The Cottbus and Drewitz airfields are known to be occupied by VP. [redacted] are assigned to MVP. [redacted] shipments in the Cottbus railroad district. [redacted]

9. [redacted] Comment. Ammunition shipments from the USSR to known Soviet ammunition depots in the GDR.

10. [redacted] Comment. These shipments were possibly consigned to a Soviet depot belonging to a military post or a division.

12. [redacted] Comment. This shipment is possibly identical with a shipment of 10 flatcars and 10 boxcars with SP guns which was reported previously. [redacted]

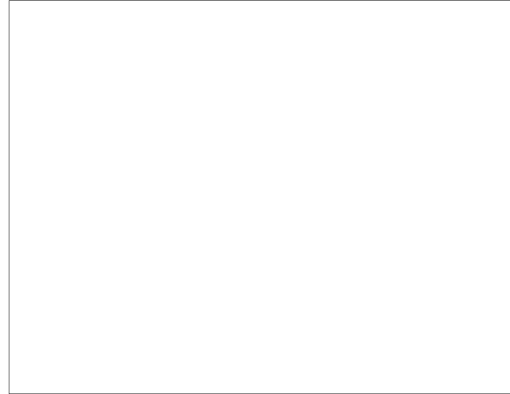
14.  Comment. This shipment possibly consisted of equipment consigned to the two regiments which are stationed in Grossenhain.
