1. In the summer of 1953, a soldier of German origin [redacted] served for the first time a term of three months. After being discharged for a second time and serving a 10 weeks' term, he was discharged on 1 October 1954. 25X1

3. On 28 January 1955, another soldier [redacted] also a German, was inducted and assigned to a unit stationed at "Chojnica" (P 54/N 41 ?). 25X1

1. Comments. It is believed that this soldier belongs to the surplus quota. Under Sections 36, 37 and 46, Defense Act of 4 February 1950, these individuals can be drafted into the territorial troops for serving their term of basic service. Under these provisions, the men have to serve a term of four months in the first year, and a term of two months in each of the following three years. These terms of service, however, can be shortened by decree.
