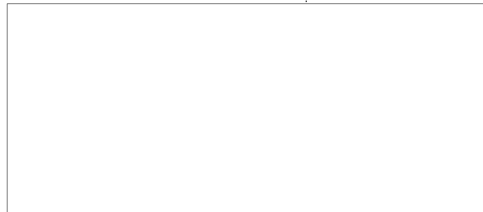

- All workers in factories in the Lodz² area were reported at the beginning of March 1955 to be required to take the so-called TOPL (Terenowa Obrona Przeciw Lotnicza) courses in anti-aircraft defense. The courses are evidently being given at the factory sites. Political officers enforce attendance by the workers.
- Skoda buses in the Lodz area have been adapted for conversion into "hospital vehicles"¹ with a capacity of 20 persons. The distribution of the conversion equipment, which was made by the Polish military, was made on a top secret basis.
