A double-based barbed wire entanglement has been constructed which cuts across the Petrisko line (sic)¹, from the Bulgarian Border Marker K-139200 to Marker K-175218. On each side of this entanglement the forest has been cleared into two areas about 20 to 30 meters wide, the ground of which is plowed. Trunks and branches of trees have been placed along the line between the forest and the edges of the cleared areas.
