2. Although there are no visible signs that Foreign Minister Mincho Neychev will retire or be replaced, his deputy, Lyuben Gerasimov, appears to be the strong man in the Foreign Ministry.
1. Comment: believes that this information is purely rumor, arising from the fact that Bulgarians in the past, such as Georgi M. Dimitrov, have held this post.
