SOURCE EVALUATIONS ARE DEFINITIVE

1. In 1954, the output of the Stalingrad Tractor Factory was 70 completed tractors per day. The present output is 100 completed tractors per day plus spare parts in such quantity as to be equivalent to an additional 100 tractors per day. Future expansion, to provide tractors for the cultivation of virgin land, is planned. Work has already begun on expansion of the shops. 25X1
2. The factory produces its own sheet steel and manufactures engines.
3. All tractors manufactured are crawlers. There are four models:
  - a. The general-purpose tractor.
  - b. A model using solid fuel.
  - c. A model specially designed for use in swamps.
  - d. A model specially designed for use on gradients (hillsides).
4. The workers work six days a week, eight hours a day.
