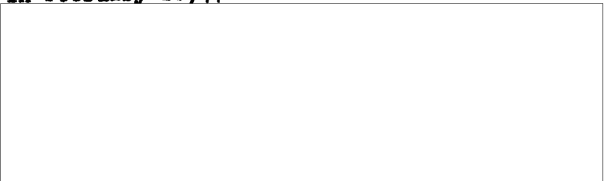

Comment. Uranium-ore shipments in March totalled 697 cars with 10,988 tons, including 148 cars with 2,220 tons from Annaberg-Buchholz, 170 cars with 2,699 tons from Breitenbrunn and 379 cars with 6,069 tons from Aue. In January 1955, a total of 9,991 tons and in February 10,471 tons of uranium ore were shipped.
