REMARKS This is UNEVALUATED Information

1. On 4 April 1955, soldiers who wore black-bordered blue epaulets were repeatedly seen at Schoenwalde airfield. Separate accounts for air-force quarters were not yet kept. There was no change in the setup of the antenna system at the drill ground.

2. ~~_____~~ Construction Bureau on Behler - Strasse in Potsdam had placed ~~_____~~ the construction of five gasoline-storage sheds measuring 7 x 15 meters with the ~~_____~~ Holzindustrie at Hennigsdorf. The gasoline-storage sheds were ~~_____~~ at Schoenwalde airfield. By early April 1955, four of the sheds had been ~~_____~~.

Comment. There is no indication of a change in the occupation of Schoenwalde airfield. Prior to late January 1955, some Po-2s which made training flights and operated with the 31st AAA Div at the Kremmen training grounds had been observed at Schoenwalde airfield.
