1. On the evening of 3 April 1955, a Soviet naval formation, composed of two cruisers and ten CC.TT, was anchored outside the port of Constanta. The two cruisers, heavy type, had two stacks located between the two masts and were of the same type as those listed on page 306 of Janes Fighting Ships, 1954-1955. The ten CC.TT were of heavy tonnage and some had a cut poop. They were of the same type as those listed on pages 309-310 of Janes. 25X1
2. The two cruisers were in deep water near the Casino and the torpedo boat-destroyers were in deep water between the cruisers and the mouth of the port. 25X1
3. Rough seas on the night of 3 April caused the formation to weigh anchor and head for open waters, but on the morning of 4 April it returned to its original point of anchor outside the harbor. 25X1
