1. In early May 1955, it was officially learned at the DHZ Kohle (German Trade Central Coal) in East Berlin that difficulties in the coal supply had been overcome. Although coal production increased only slightly, it was planned to store coal for the winter of 1955/56 beginning in June.

the supply of the brown coal briquettes for the local industry (trade enterprises and nationalized enterprises which were not centrally controlled) had to be discontinued at once. Local industry was to be delivered raw brown coal exclusively.
